Suggested Guidelines for the Kiwanis/CASA Partnership:

- 1 Decide as a club how you will participate in this project.
- 2 Collaborate with other clubs in area.
- 3 Set up committee: a few, consistent people should work with each CASA office.
- 4 Meet with CASA and discuss what supplies would best fit with their program.
- 5 Deliver Activity Bags at this time, or when you deliver supplies.
Activity Bags are for the use of the CASA Volunteers.
- 6 Invite CASA to provide a program so club is familiar with CASA.
- 7 Depending upon storage space they have available consider providing a storage container for their use.
- 8 Some supplies are such that volunteers can check them out from the CASA office, other supplies will be consumable.
- 9 Keep in touch with their office. Restock supplies as needed.
- 10 It is our plan that this project will be an ongoing partnership with Kiwanis and CASA.
- 11 Please keep in touch with the state Kiwanis/CASA Partnership Committee.
Let us know your willingness to participate, when Activity Bags and supplies are delivered.

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Suggested supplies to be provided by Kiwanis for CASA Volunteers

Volunteers work with children birth to 18,
A variety of activities for these ages and for boys & girls are needed.

Playing cards: goldfish, old maid, uno, regular cards for teens
Travel size board games for varying ages
Crayons, Colored pencils
Coloring books—Children, teens
Playdough, puzzles, craft items
Soft balls for tossing or stress balls
Small puppets, small soft stuffed toys
Manipulative activities; small magnet board with letters & numbers
Things you would use to keep kids busy and interacting with you!
Journals, Books
